All proceeds serve the needs in our Ocean County community, where we **currently assist six local charities.** Our contributions have been extremely generous, and now, we need more helpers!

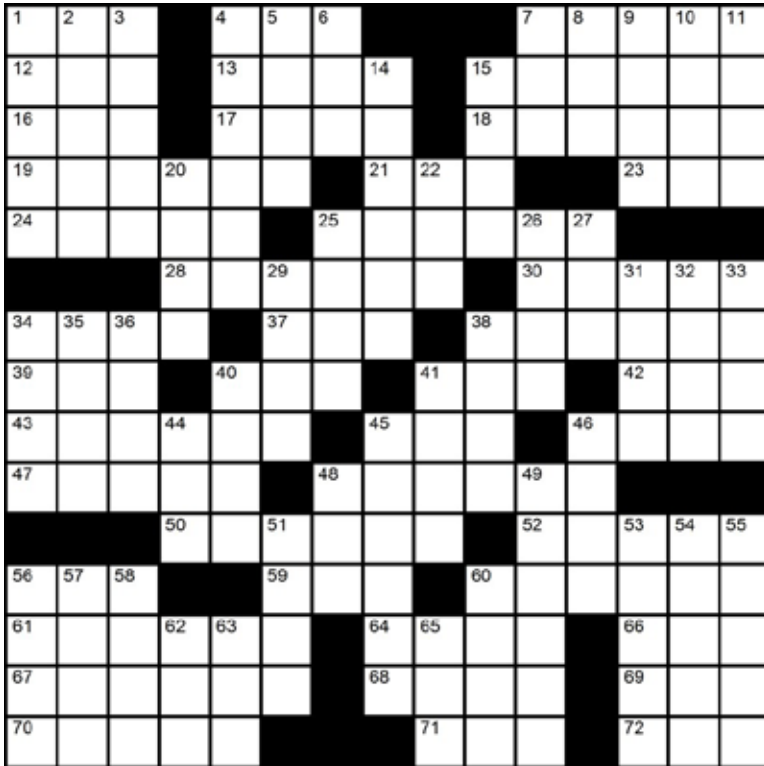

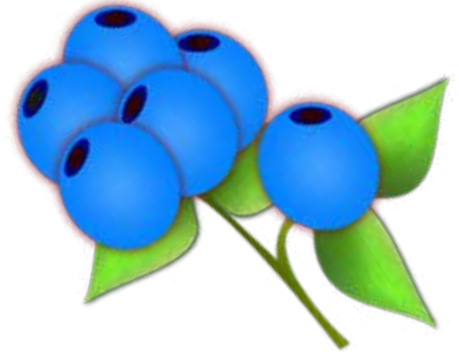

RICKY LAUREN'S BLUEBERRY CRISP

INGREDIENTS

- 3 Cups fresh blueberries
- 2 Tablespoons sugar
- Zest and juice of 1 lemon
- ¾ Cups all purpose flour
- 1 Cup packed light brown sugar
- 1 ½ Cup rolled oats
- 6 Tablespoons salted butter softened



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees.
2. Toss the blueberries, sugar, lemon zest, and juice together in a bowl. Pour into a 9 inch square baking dish.
3. In the bowl of a food processor, combine the flour, brown sugar, oats, and butter and pulse until the mixture resembles crumbs. Spread this over the berries.
4. Bake until golden on top 40-45 minutes. Serve and top with vanilla or fresh whipped topping
