

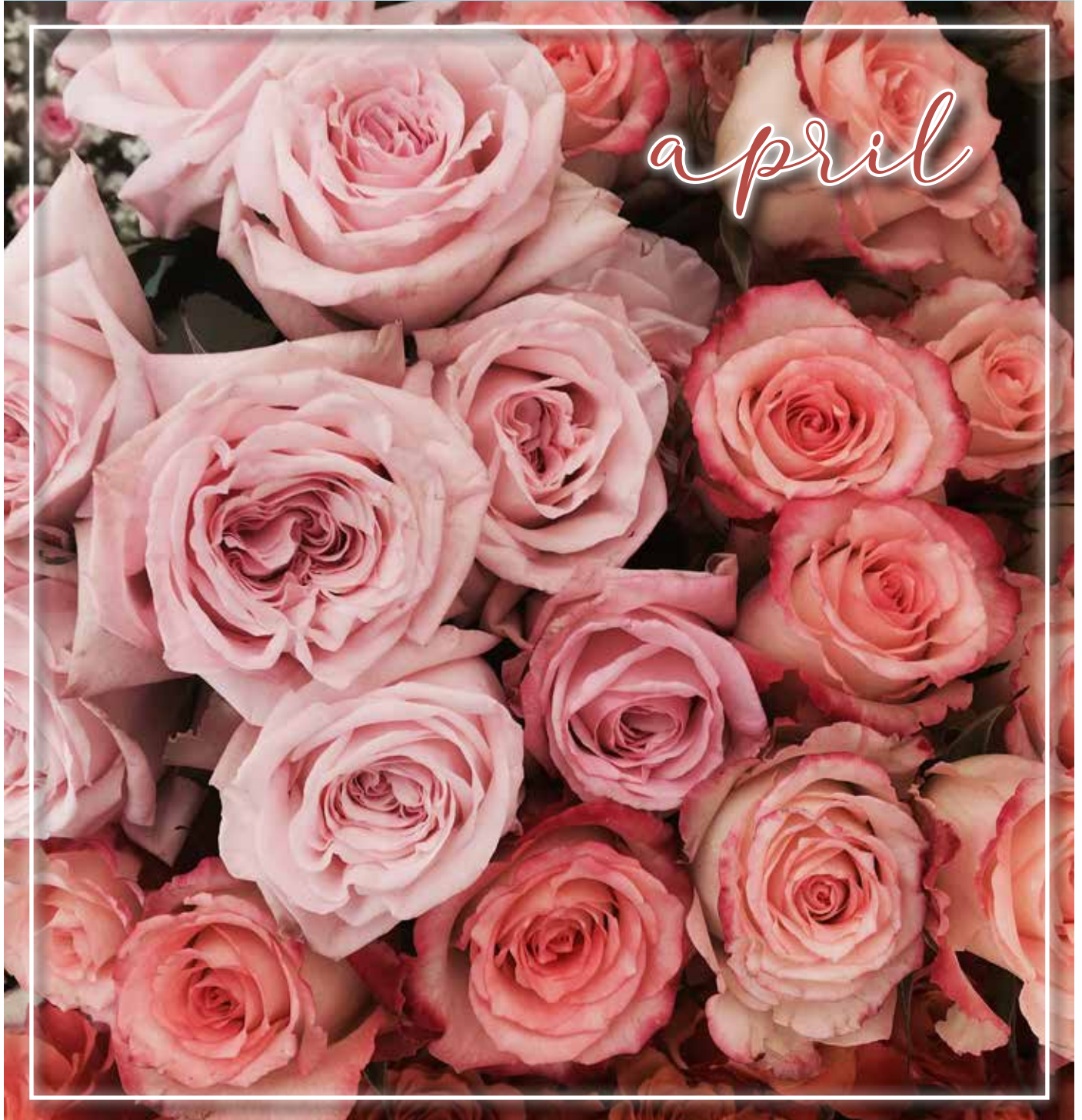

RENEE'S REMINDERS

TENANT'S RESPONSIBILITIES


In an effort to maintain a five-star reputation, the owners of Homestead Run and the Business Office will be publishing a series of reminders and modifications to standard lease, rules, and regulations. This column will be called Renee's Reminders, and Renee means business!


 Spring is just around the corner. It's time for a clean-up. **Be sure your yard is free of debris, garbage, and excess equipment.** This is what your shed is for! We are in the process of revamping our rules and regulations. **If you do not comply, in the future, you may risk a fine or eviction.**

 All changes or improvements to the outside of your home or your land must be approved by the Homestead Run Business Office. **Examples:** Paint color choice, additions, landscaping, driveways, etc. We don't always say no, so don't be shy to ask!

 Parking or storage of oversized, commercial vehicles, trailers of any kind, boats, unregistered or inoperable vehicles, etc. are prohibited. **We have the right to tow these vehicles at your expense after 48 hours of written notice.**



 **No tenant is permitted to sell, list, or transfer ownership of their home without notice to the Business Office.** Realtors need to visit the Business Office to sign essential paperwork. Failure to follow procedure may result in the rejection of new tenant applications and the loss of your sale.

 If you have a pet, it is your responsibility to clean up after it, ensure that it does not go on your neighbor's property or the streets to do its business, and **under no circumstances should your pets be released to roam free.** There are two dog areas, one located near the clubhouse, and one by the Warner Way entrance. There are no other dog areas in the park. **PS – Do not feed stray animals or the darn geese!**



Power in the wings

I don't know about you, but I love watching one hour TV dramas. I've been with NBC's *This Is Us* from the very beginning. The emotion and the heart of the series gripped me from its first episode. I'm not a big crier, but something about the way the writers weave the stories of the Pearson family and those closest to them makes me feel something every time. I can hardly believe that the series is coming to a close this May. After so many seasons, I'm going to miss tuning in on Tuesday nights. When TV characters sneak into your heart, it can be cathartic to tune in and take the ride with them.

In watching a recent episode that followed the matriarch of one side of the family, they showed her journey from childhood to adulthood, ballet being a common thread in her world. Beth once lost her footing, suffering a loss in her family as a teen. Because of that, she wasn't able to devote her time, remaining in the right headspace, to continue pursuing her dancing dream. Instead, she took another path, eventually circling back to what spoke to her soul. She became a dance instructor, mentoring those that felt they'd been left behind.

In a poignant point of the episode, one of the dancers that she'd chosen to perform in a recital took a fall. She was embarrassed, unable to move on the stage until Beth met her where she was. She told the dancer that she believed in her, and that it was the dancer's choice. She could remain there on the stage at her side, bore the crowd into leaving, or the young dancer could stand up, start over, and wow them. She opted for the latter, the crowd cheering her on.

As the episode came to a close, Beth phoned the instructor that failed to stand by her side through a difficult time. He failed to encourage her the way she chose to encourage those that she mentored. With strength, she

told her former instructor that there's power in waiting in the wings. During the final scene, a bulletin board showed the faces of all of the dancers that Beth encouraged, those that she had stood by, no matter their adversity. For those dancers, she waited in the wings, and she changed their worlds.

I had tears in my eyes, wishing and hoping that I could find a similar purpose in life. I wanted to know that I could leave that positive, lasting impression. The following morning, I had a conversation with someone I love who told me that my presence is powerful, that I do make a difference. She reminded me of how I take care of my aging father, how I always drop everything if a friend needs me, and how I write and share my words, my thoughts with others. She said I, too, am a person that waits in the wings. I had been so despondent the night prior, thinking that I had somehow missed my mark, that I should be doing more. That gentle reminder made me breathe easier, made me realize that, oftentimes, the power is in the little things.

CARROT CAKE

INGREDIENTS

For the cake:

- 3 cups grated carrot
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 cups sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 4 large eggs
- 1 1/2 cups vegetable oil
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 (8-ounce) can crushed pineapples with juice
- 3/4 cup chopped pecans

For the frosting:

- 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, at room temperature or softened
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter, at room temperature or softened
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 3 1/2 cups powdered sugar

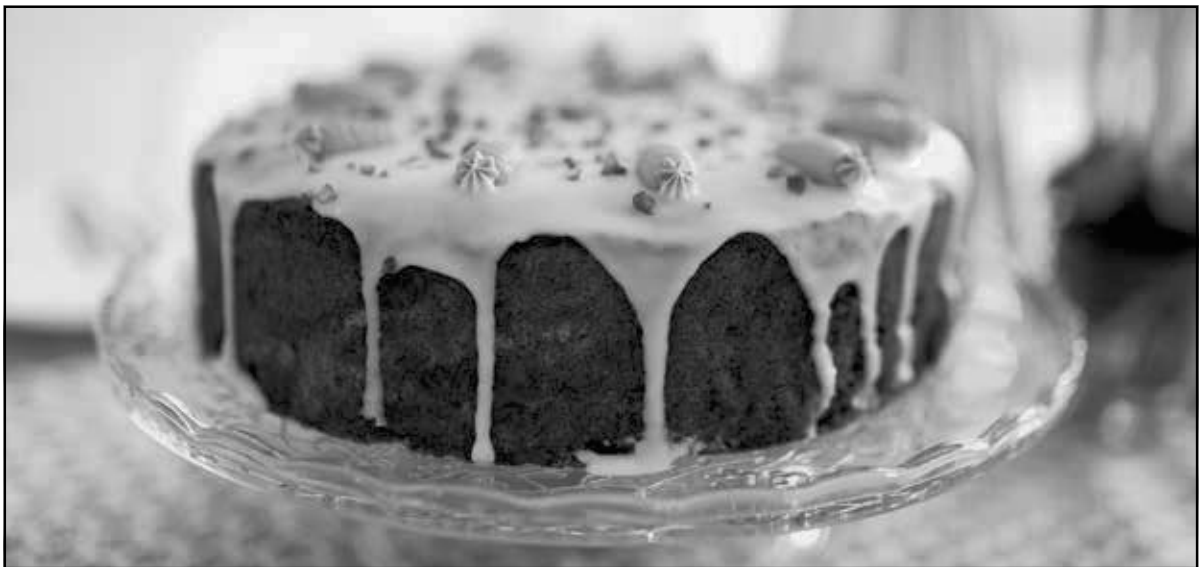
INSTRUCTIONS

Make the cake:

1. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Grease and flour a 9x13-inch cake pan.
2. In a large bowl, toss the grated carrots, flour, sugar, baking soda, salt and cinnamon to combine.
3. Add the eggs, oil, vanilla extract, crushed pineapple and chopped pecans to the bowl. Stir until combined.
4. Pour the batter into the prepared cake pan and bake for 35 to 40 minutes, until a toothpick inserted comes out clean.
5. Transfer the cake, still in the pan, to a cooling rack to cool completely and then invert it onto a large cutting board.

Make the frosting:

1. With a handheld electric mixer, beat the cream cheese until smooth, scraping down the sides as needed. Add the butter and vanilla extract, beating until well combined.
2. Add the powdered sugar and beat on low until combined. Once the cake is completely cool, frost and serve.

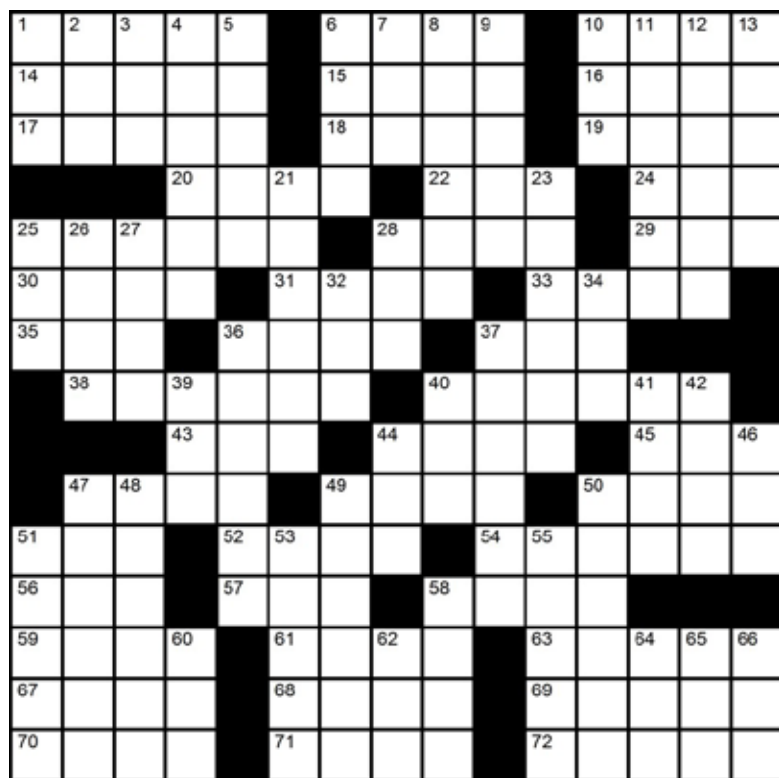
